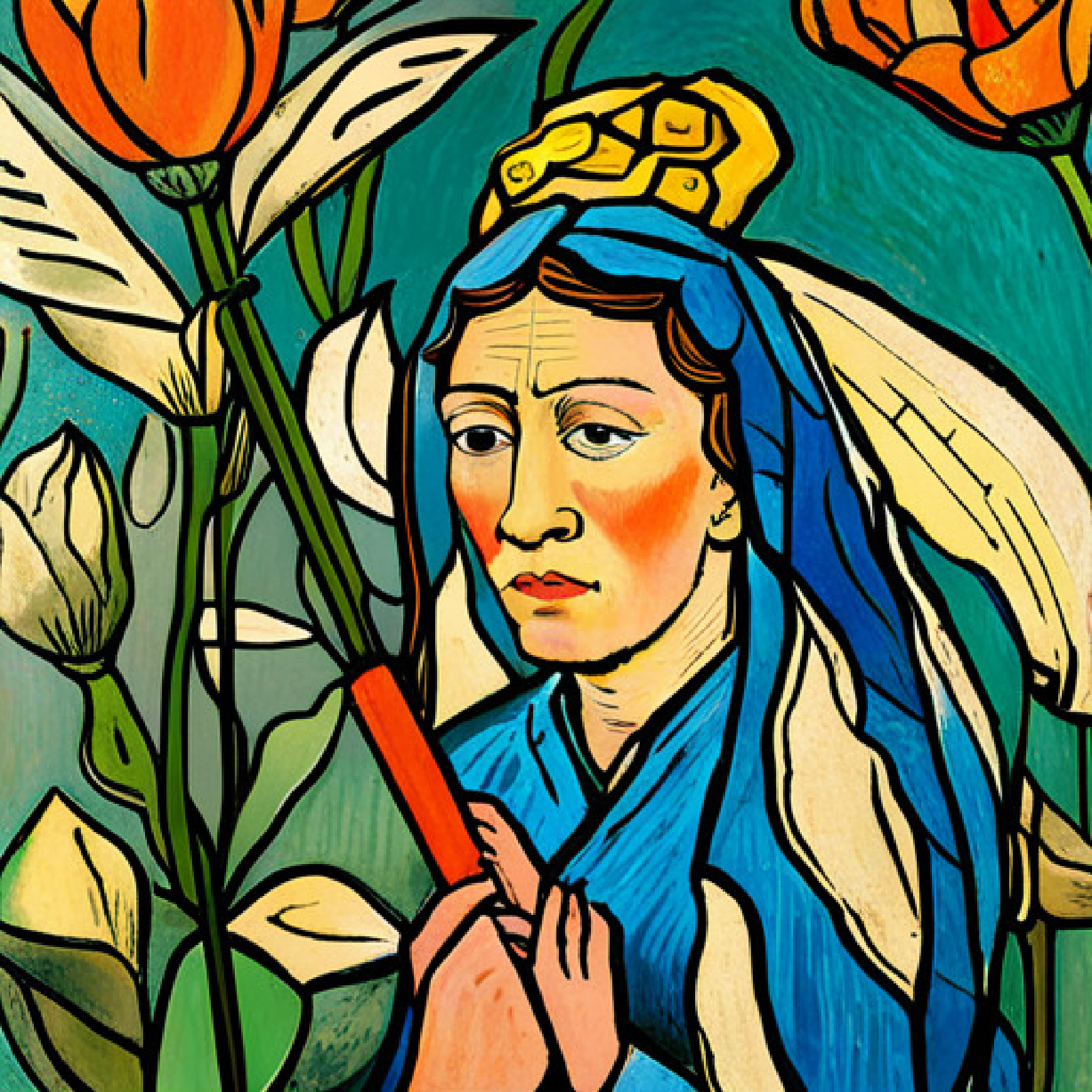
When Lily reached the castle, she was greeted by a group of fairies, who warned her of the dangers inside. But Lily was brave, and she entered the castle, determined to find the queen.
